The programme for the celebration of National Education Day 2020 was observed by Govt. Zirtiri Residential Science College by organizing webinar using Google meet.

The Programme was chaired by Dr. R. Lalengmawia, Associate Professor.

Keynote Address: The Principal Prof. B. Zoliana gave a keynote address and he stressed about the life of Abdul Kalam Muhiyuddin Ahmed (11 Nov 1888 – 22 Feb 1958) who was an Indian scholar and a political leader during Indian Independence Movement. He was the first Minister of education in the Indian Government, and his contribution to establishing education foundation was recognized by celebrating his birthday as National education Day, which is celebrated each year on 11/11/20202, across India.

There was one resource person: Prof. Lalbiakdiki Hnamte Director, College Development Council, MZU

She talked about the meaning of Education, how education aims to make a person a better human being, for himself/herself, for family, society and for the world at large. And how to utilize the knowledge one gains in schools and college in real life. Education by just learning byheart is not complete, students must understand what he/she is learning. She stressed that the popular saying "It's my life" must be replaced by 'It's our Life" because everyone in a society is dependent on one another. Educated people should know how to live in a society and have a certain contribution in a community.

She spoke about the four pillars of education. She tried to motivate the students to be clear on what they want to become, and why, and to strive to achieve their goals. Education is not just learning through by-heart system. Although students are usually judged from the

marks they scored in exams, a real educated person and his worth is seen on how he/she portrays himself/herself in his attitude towards others. While encouraging the students to be worthy citizens, she also urged the teachers to try their utmost in guiding their students to become worthy and educated people.




